Granny's Cocoa Cream Pie

It's simple and tasty.
This really was a simple desert
often used during the 30's and 40's.

½ c. cocoa

1/4 c. cornstarch (or 1/2 c. all-purpose flour)

3 egg yolks

1 ½ c. sugar

 $\frac{1}{4}$ tsp. salt

2 c. milk

1 tsp. vanilla

Mix cocoa, cornstarch, beaten egg yolks; sugar and salt, then add milk gradually, while stirring in a pot over medium-high heat. Cook until thick, beating it smooth. Cream pies take some time to thicken, so stir... and stir (10-15 min). Pour into a pre-baked pie shell. Put in the fridge to chill, add whipped cream, or use the left-over egg whites for a meringue topping!


