
ALAN WITHAM

Chicken Casserole

6 chicken breasts or 8 chicken tenders
1 stick butter or margarine
1 can cream of chicken soup
1/4 c. milk
salt and pepper
6 slices swiss cheese
Pepperidge Farm Herb Seasoned Classic Stuffing

Melt the butter or margarine. Dip the chicken breasts or tenders in the butter or margarine then place them in a 9x13 casserole dish. Sprinkle with salt and pepper to taste. Mix the milk with the cream of chicken soup then spread evenly over the chicken. Place the Swiss cheese slices on top of the cream of chicken soup and milk mixture. Mix the remaining butter or margarine with the Pepperidge Farm Stuffing. Sprinkle this mixture on top of the cheese. Bake in 350-degree oven for one hour uncovered.
