Application (Take Home Truths)

Today, you stand at your own Caesarea Philippi and Jesus asks you, tenderly and clearly, “Who do you say that I am?”

If to you Jesus is only “the man upstairs” whose main purpose is to make everybody happy and feel good about themselves; if He is a Lord that requires no real worship, self-sacrifice, obedience, submission, or surrender; if He is a Lord whose work to save us doesn’t make us any different than we were before we knew Him; if His commands to us are really more like suggestions and only for the “serious Christians”; if He has no authority over your life; if He is any of those things only to you, then you have missed Him, misunderstood who He is, and mistaken His identity.

However, if Jesus is to you Savior, Messiah, and Lord; If your heart and life proclaims this as true, loudly and without reservation then you know exactly who Jesus is and you join the chorus of Peter and so many faithful others who answer Jesus’ question with joyful certainty “You are the Christ”.

Mark 8: 22-30 Here is a blind man brought to Christ by his friends. Therein appeared the faith of those that brought him. If those who are spiritually blind, do not pray for themselves, yet their friends and relations should pray for them, that Christ would be pleased to touch them. The cure was wrought gradually, which was not usual in our Lord's miracles. Christ showed in what method those commonly are healed by his grace, who by nature are spiritually blind. At first, their knowledge is confused; but, like the light of the morning, it shines more and more to the perfect day, and then they see all things clearly. Slighting Christ's favours is forfeiting them; and he will make those who do so know the worth of privileges by the want of them.
