Because Jesus is the Christ - this means He must _____ many things (rejection, death, but will ultimately resurrect).

In v35-38, Jesus is impressing on us and making clear what the correct _____ should be of one who receives His gift of salvation.

To put our faith in Christ for salvation means we observe His life – the sacrifice He made being obedient even to death - and we in turn live in the light of this truth as we make Him _____ of our lives.

Application (Take Home Truths)

What does that mean for us - or you in your life in 2021?

As we think about this practically - I want us to see the power of the “ordinary” Christian life. This is simply living out what God has told us to do in the ways he has told us to live by the power of the Holy Spirit. In a large part, for you and I to deny ourselves, take up our cross, and follow Him looks like waking up every day with a resolve to live out the gospel in all we do - at work, school, practice, at home, and on social media. It means keeping our mind on the things of God and not of man - on the kingdom of God and not of man. It means being determined to put away the old self and not give sin a foothold in our lives. It means being committed to live our lives so Christ is known and worshipped.
