As we think about this practically - I want us to see the power of the "ordinary" Christian life. This is simply living out what God has told us to do in the ways he has told us to live by the power of the Holy Spirit. In a large part, for you and I to deny ourselves, take up our cross, and follow Him looks like waking up every day with a resolve to live out the gospel in all we do - at work, school, practice, at home, and on social media. It means keeping our mind on the things of God and not of man - on the kingdom of God and not of man. It means being determined to put away the old self and not give sin a foothold in our lives. It means being committed to live our lives so Christ is known and worshipped.
