# The plot to kill both Jesus and Lazarus.

Now a great many of the Jews knew He was there; and they came, not for Jesus' sake only, but they might also see Lazarus, whom He had raised from the dead. But the chief priests plotted to put *Lazarus* to death also, because *on account of him many of the Jews went away and believed in Jesus.*+

The chief priests plotted to put Lazarus to death also: The chief priests were mostly Sadducees, and the Sadducees didn't believe in the resurrection. Lazarus was a living example of life after death, and having him around was an embarrassment to their theological system. For them, there was only one solution to this embarrassing problem – to put Lazarus to death also.

On account of him many of the Jews went away and believed in Jesus: This made the problem of the chief priests worse. The miracle of raising Lazarus from the dead drew many people to Jesus. Therefore, in the opinion of these religious leaders, Lazarus also had to be stopped.
