When the three disciples make their way down the mountain, they enter a very different scene and reality than the one they had just left in the_____.

Jesus is a Savior that demands and requires faithfulness; He will not permit people to _____ in their sin.

Jesus engaged this father personally because He wanted him to know He was not some vague impersonal force for healing but rather He was a person - a personal and real_____.

In verse 23, Jesus is _____ and asking the father to believe in Him fully and completely.

God has not commanded us to “feel” but to know; to know that no matter what He is always _____ and in control.

Jesus is _____ with the kind of prayer that says “I believe; help my unbelief.”

Jesus’ answer to the disciple’s question in verse 28 (“Why could we not cast it out?”) is _____ and significant.

Jesus is teaching us that followers of God must be careful to make sure we are in consistent _____ with God - communicating and communing with Him regularly.

Application (Take Home Truths)

The mistake of the nine other disciples is that because they had achieved success previously, they had neglected to pray. They were relying on their own power and ability instead of their dependence on God in prayer to Him.

We can do the same thing, far too easily, as well and must be careful to ensure we are consistently in fellowship with God - through prayer and study of His Word.

Would you commit to be a person of prayer? The very best days of First Baptist Church can be ahead of us but we must be people of prayer.
