| Application (Take Home Truths)  |

We must take sin as serious as Jesus does.

The best days of our church can be ahead of us. But if we do not take sin seriously; If we do not take seriously the call to lead people away from sin; If we do not follow the command of God to love our brothers and sisters well by pulling them back from dangerous snares of sin; If we do not take our own personal holiness serious and fight sin, doing whatever it takes to make war against it; If we do not take our own witness of the gospel to the world seriously; Then, I am afraid God will not take us very seriously when we pray to be used by Him and for Him as a people and a church.

Let us fight our sin by prayer, reading/memorizing scripture, confession and accountability to one another, choosing not to engage in activity that might lead us to sin, and by reminding ourselves of the gospel and work of Christ to make us a new creation through the gospel.
