In our text, Christ will show us the \_\_\_\_\_ of the believer to both corporate and personal holiness, as well as the necessity of being a faithful witness for Him.

Jesus is \_\_\_\_\_ about our holiness and He wants us to be concerned about another believer’s holiness as well.

Jesus is not advocating for a literal cutting off of limbs because that would do no good. What is needed is a cutting of the heart to see sin, repent, and believe in Christ. Only the \_\_\_\_\_ can do that.

The \_\_\_\_\_ of a believer’s life in the fight against sin is in view here within this text.

The \_\_\_\_\_ of sin is death, and unrepentant and habitual sin takes people to hell.

Hell is not only the absence of God, but it is also the place where the \_\_\_\_\_ of God is felt fully on the sinner because of their sin and refusal to turn to Him in faith and repentance.

“Be killing \_\_\_\_\_ or it will be killing you”.

The true disciple of Christ is one who is not comfortable or at peace with sin but rather one who \_\_\_\_\_ holiness with passion, out of a gratefulness to God for His work in their life.

To claim to know Christ and follow Him as Lord and yet live in open and unrepentant rebellion against Him is to make a mockery of the gospel we claim. Like salt that has lost its saltiness, we lose our effectiveness as \_\_\_\_\_ for Him in the world.

**Application (Take Home Truths)**

We must take sin as serious as Jesus does.

The best days of our church can be ahead of us. But if we do not take sin seriously; If we do not take seriously the call to lead people away from sin; If we do not follow the command of God to love our brothers and sisters well by pulling them back from dangerous snares of sin; If we do not take our own personal holiness serious and fight sin, doing whatever it takes to make war against it; If we do not take our own witness of the gospel to the world seriously; Then, I am afraid God will not take us very seriously when we pray to be used by Him and for Him as a people and a church.

Let us fight our sin by prayer, reading/memorizing scripture, confession and accountability to one another, choosing not to engage in activity that might lead us to sin, and by reminding ourselves of the gospel and work of Christ to make us a new creation through the gospel.

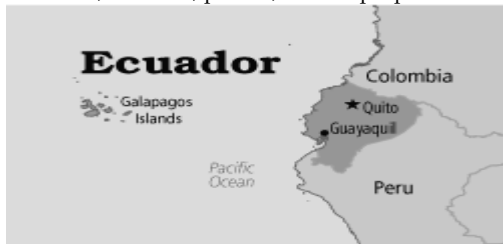
