#### Application (Take Home Truths)

Jesus holds a high view of marriage - and calls his followers to do the same - because an unbiblical and casual approach to divorce distorts the image of God that is symbolized in marriage. This standard - based on God's never-ending and never-failing love is actually really good news for all of us.

Every single one of us is guilty of falling short of God's original design. For some it might be within God's design for marriage and for others it might be a completely different way. But all of us are guilty in some way and are in need of the grace and forgiveness of God that comes through Jesus Christ. A grace that is given to us through the gospel and imaged for us in the gift of marriage.

Christ's never-ending, never-failing, never-giving up, covenant keeping love is just that: never-ending, never-failing, and never-giving up. If you have found yourself guilty of breaking God's design in the persons, promise, permanence of marriage or perhaps in another way, know that there is grace and forgiveness for you in the gospel. The image of Christ's dedication and love to the church is a reminder that no one is beyond the grace and forgiveness of Jesus Christ. "What God has joined together", means you too, Christian. Christ will not separate Himself, His love, and His forgiveness from those who repent and believe in Him.
