**“Who is This Man?”**  
**A Study through the Gospel of Mark**  
*“Who Goes To Heaven?”*  
**Mark 10: 13-27**

In our text we learn about the kind of person that will go to \_\_\_\_\_.

In the culture of Jesus’s day, \_\_\_\_\_ were understood to bring little to no worth to society - they were helpless, dependent, needy, and unable to contribute in a meaningful way.

Jesus was \_\_\_\_\_. To be indignant is to show annoyance, even anger, at the unfair treatment of another.

The Kingdom of God (Heaven) is given to those who \_\_\_\_\_ to Jesus. It is a gift that must be \_\_\_\_\_ individually and personally.

When it comes to being \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of your sin, we all must come to Jesus like children: helpless, dependent, needy, and understanding our inability to contribute in any meaningful way.

The person who will go to heaven is the one who does not rely on their ability or “goodness” but rather the one who realizes their own helpless sinfulness and comes to Jesus to receive the gospel and trust Him for \_\_\_\_\_ and repentance of \_\_\_\_\_.

The rich young man’s question assumes that \_\_\_\_\_ is dependent on him doing something.

The \_\_\_\_\_ is not “go do” but rather, “done”.

In His response, Jesus tells the man to \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.

Jesus wants this man, just like He wants you, to understand and believe that He is the truest \_\_\_\_\_ of the heart.

**Application (Take Home Truths)**

The rich young ruler had done all the right things: he had come to the right person, Jesus, with the right question on his mind. But Jesus, in an act of love (v21), exposed and showed him what he lacked. The man’s “god” was not the Lord but rather it was money, wealth, and possessions. He rejected Christ because he is unwilling to give these things up, as Christ asked him to.

Your “god” is whatever you are unwilling to give up for God. The right action for you today is to come to Jesus, stop fighting, and believe with childlike trust and dependence. Don’t let whatever you’re harboring in your heart (your “god”) keep you from Jesus.
