In our text this morning, we will consider and think deeply about three things:

Jesus was _____ and given willingly by God the Father and He goes willingly to the cross as God the Son.

Jesus: Your wrath taker (v38)

The _____ and the _____ are both references to the divine wrath and judgement of God for sin that will be poured out on Jesus at His death.

A right understanding of what Jesus accomplished on the cross should drive _____ to live in pursuit of holiness, by the power of the gospel.

The good news of the gospel is that the grace of God is available to _____ who repents and trusts in Christ’s wrath taking death and His resurrection.

Jesus: Your ransom (v45)

Jesus Christ came for one purpose: to give His _____ in the place of sinners.

Jesus gave His life as a ransom to pay the full price of sin to _____.

The wonderful news of the gospel is that your debt has been _____ and there is no more condemnation for those who are in Christ!

Application (Take Home Truths)

Our sin and rebellion require the wrath of God because His holiness and justice require sin be punished. The good news is Jesus Christ came to take this punishment and stand as the ransom for those who turn from sin and believe in Him.

The Bible teaches us the wrath of God remains on those who continue in their rejection of Jesus’s work on the cross (John 3:36).

If you do not know Christ, turn to Him *today* and be forgiven.

If you do know Him, live in the truth that there is no more condemnation, your debt has been paid. By the Holy Spirit, commit to living a life that honors Him.

Let’s commit to seeing this church be a bright and shining light for the gospel. A place that says “come as you are but leave different because of the gospel.” Let’s stand strong on God’s Word and what it calls us to even while we point others to Jesus: their delivered, their wrath taker, their ransom.
