## "Who is This Man?" A Study through the Gospel of Mark

*"The Fault In Our Hearts"* Mark 10:35-52 Pastor Chance McConnell March 21, 2021

In our text, we are going to look at two examples: One where the focus is wrongly placed on \_\_\_\_\_\_ and one where the focus is rightly placed on \_\_\_\_\_\_.

After Jesus's proclamation of his own suffering and death, James and John come to him with a \_\_\_\_\_\_ of their own.

Application (Take Home Truths)

The good news of the gospel is that while sin has indeed made us all blind beggars, Jesus hears the call and cry of those who turn to Him in faith and repentance.

The call to be a follower of Jesus is the call to trust and understand your own need and how that need has been met fully in Christ. Then, in that same grace, commit your life to Him and follow Him. Ask yourself: What do your requests of Jesus look like? Do they look more like James and John or Bartimaeus?
