The first words that Jesus spoke to the disciples in the upper room were "Peace to you!" That is a truth the disciples desperately needed to hear that day and I know it is a truth you need to hear today as well.

This day - Easter Sunday 2021 - that same savior speaks those same words to you, "Peace to You".

The good news of Easter is that you don't have to go on beating yourself up about your sin. You don't have to live in the past guilt of something you once did. The gospel of Jesus means you don't have to remain as you are when entered into this place. Rather, you can be brought back into fellowship with God because the risen and resurrected Christ took on death and sin - your sin - so you could be forgiven.
