Application (Take Home Truths)								

This parable is about the religious leaders of Israel (v12) but it is also a parable about us - about all people. It is a story about anyone who has ever spurned the love of God and refused to turn to Him through faith in Jesus.

There is a temptation for us all to want to categorize sin into the "big sins" and only focus on the more common and well known ones. But sin is so deceptive that it cuts deep in our heart. The Bible says it is actually a part of who we are as people (Genesis 6: 5; Ephesians 2: 1-3). But the good news is that Jesus came and died because of this reason. He came to save those of us - which is all of us - who are ravaged by sin.

This is a parable of grace - for you - that you might hear, receive, and understand what Jesus Christ has done for you!
