It is to love God and not love your neighbor, neither can you truly love your neighbor and not love God.

Jesus redefinesto mean not only other brother and sister Christians but also all people - even those who we might consider enemies.
The reality is that no one has ever loved God with <i>all</i> of themselves (heart, soul, mind, and strength). No one has ever loved their neighbor truly as themselves.

The reality is that no one has ever loved God with *all* of themselves (heart, soul, mind, and strength). No one has ever loved their neighbor truly as themselves. Jesus is the only one who has perfectly lived in total submission, worship, and devotion, toward God. Jesus is the only one who has ever loved His neighbor and loved His enemies as Himself. Indeed, while you and I were yet sinners - enemies and hostile to God, unwilling and unable to submit to His will and ways - still, even then, Christ went to the cross for us. He gave His life as a ransom for many and rose again on the third day so that you and I could defeat death and sin by repentance and faith in Him.

The only way into the Kingdom of God is through faith and trust in Jesus Christ - realizing that you can't keep the greatest (or even one of the commandments) of God and that you are desperate for Jesus to do for you that which you cannot do for yourself: trade to you His righteousness and obedience in exchange for your halfhearted obedience and sinful rebellion toward God. This is the way in the kingdom.
