Application:
1. Then, and now, Christ discloses Himself to us in our trouble and shares with us His dominion over difficulty.
2. Sometimes our obedience to Christ places us in difficulty. Faithfulness to Christ brings no immunity from difficulty. It almost ensures it. To follow Christ in this age guarantees storms. The storm at Sea was preparatory. Peter and the others would spend a lifetime in storms because of obedience to Him
